



City of Peoria - CDBG Household Assistance Program Guidelines

The City of Peoria is accepting applications for the Household Assistance Program. This program is designed to provide funds to renters and homeowners delinquent on mortgage and rent payments due to COVID-19 impacts. Funds will be provided for three months of delinquent rent and mortgage payments as well as utilities to approved applicants.

Basic contact information is being collected for a lottery. If selected for the lottery, entrants will need to complete additional income and household information to ensure income qualification.

Applications will be available beginning Monday, July 6th at 8:00 am and ending on Friday, July 17th at 3:00 pm. A brief video training session will be available on July 6th to guide applicants through the initial application process.

Households will be selected via lottery on Tuesday, July 21st at 10:00 am. Applicants are not required to be present. A list of the lottery order will be posted online by 4:00 pm.

To be eligible:

- The property must be located within the corporate boundaries within the City of Peoria
- Total household income must be at or below 80% Area Median Income (AMI) by household size
- Household must show a negative impact due to COVID-19 and be unable to pay
- No fees or fines can be owed to the City of Peoria
- No outstanding code violations on the property
- Property must complete a code enforcement self-inspection form

Additional program details:

- Up to \$5,000 for up to three (3) months of assistance
- Rent/mortgage and utilities such as water, electric and gas will be covered
- Payments must be made by the City directly to landlord or utility company
